Course description

This course provides a skill-based training in an independent research project on chosen topic conducted under the supervision of a teaching faculty of the MA program in International Language Education. The student is required to produce a substantial research paper at the end of the project. This cannot be taken concurrently with *MILE6000 Supervised Teaching Practicum*.

All research projects should be related to the two specialized concentrations of the MALE curriculum, i.e. Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL), and Teaching Chinese as a Second Language (TCSL), and are under the supervision of a teaching faculty of the MA in ILE program.

By the end of Fall term, the program office will gather and compile all the titles of projects to be offered by SHSS faculty in that year. Interested students can further discuss with the respective project supervisor for the details of the project. Upon being accepted by a supervisor, students should report to the program office the project title and submit a research project outline for record before registering with ARRO.
